THANK YOU JOHN AND JEANETTE

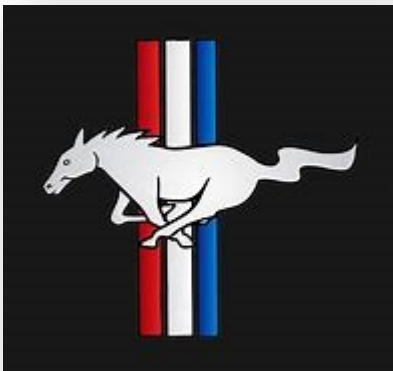
