


The Pony Express Red River Classic Mustang Club November 2019 News letter





Jeans Cleaning Tip

Back in September you learned about cloth seats. Now let's talk about leather. Leather seats need extra care because of the premium material. To clean stains from leather try one of these ways..#1 Use nail polish remover or rubbing alcohol. Blotting with a cotton ball will slowly lift the stain. Clean off with warm water and dish soap. #2 Use a non gel toothpaste. Dab some on the stain then scrub with a clean toothbrush. Clean off with warm water..
