

Since I have been actively working on creating a new more user friendly website, I will continue into 2020 as the Internet Director.

I am in the process of getting the RRCMC.com domain name connected to the new site, and also trying to get our club pictures moved over as well. The only vacancy we have at this time is Vice President going into the New Year. Hopefully I will try to recruit an active club member in good standing to take over that position soon. Following the Board member Elections, we went over to Ernie and Sabrina's new home for our Christmas party. Thanks to both of them for opening their wonderful new home to the club for our party. I think everyone had a much more enjoyable time being able to move around and visit with everyone at the party rather than sitting in the same place at the dinner table like we have in the past when celebrating at a restaurant. Hopefully this departure from Christmas Parties at a Restaurant will continue to be held at a club members house, making it much more enjoyable for those attending. I know I had a great time walking around talking and visiting with everyone.

Over Christmas week, I finally got to get some time in Lane Butlers Garage to upgrade my cooling system in my 93 fox body convertible. I have been accumulating parts for the job since before our show in September based on different opinions about the repairs. I had over time developed a front main seal oil leak, and a coolant leak that I was unable to really find. Plus, I noticed that the car started to run hotter than normal, most likely due to a clogged radiator and worn out water pump. So I started out by ordering a set of hoses, and found a high performance water pump that moves 30 percent more water than stock pumps. My Brother in law saw my collection of parts, and recommended I get an aluminum

radiator, so I was able to find one at 5.0 Resto.com that was reasonably priced, and was a 3 core radiator as opposed to the factory 2 core. One of my customers said I probably should get a timing chain set also, since I had to remove the timing chain cover to replace the front main seal. So I went ahead and ordered that too. Lane and I set to work on the car at 9:am Monday the 23rd of December. Worked all day, and had the car finished and doing test drives by 9:30 that night. As it turned out, the water pump and radiator had to be original parts. Both had Ford stampings on them, and were corroded and quite nasty. Upon removing the timing cover revealed a lot of play in the timing chain, so that along with the gears needed replacement as well. I think the worst tedious labor intensive problem we had was cleaning the old gasket and rtv material off the timing cover, and block of the engine where the two went together. Thanks to Lane Butlers garage, tools, expertise and experience, I was not only able to clean up my coolant and oil leak problems, but now my engine runs much quieter, and so much cooler. Yes, it was a lot of work, and I am still suffering from random muscle soreness as I write this article 4 days later, but it was well worth it. Lane and I had a great time doing the work as well, talking about our families, and mostly me benefiting from his experience as we remedied minor problems on the fly. Thanks again to Lane and especially Rhonda his wife for allowing me to tie him up all day.

I hope everyone had a Merry Christmas and a fantastic start to the new Year. I hope to see everyone in 2020 as we get through the winter and the car show season starts up again in March.
