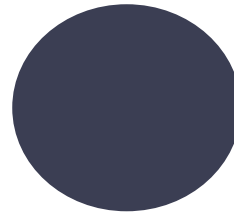


Hello Everyone

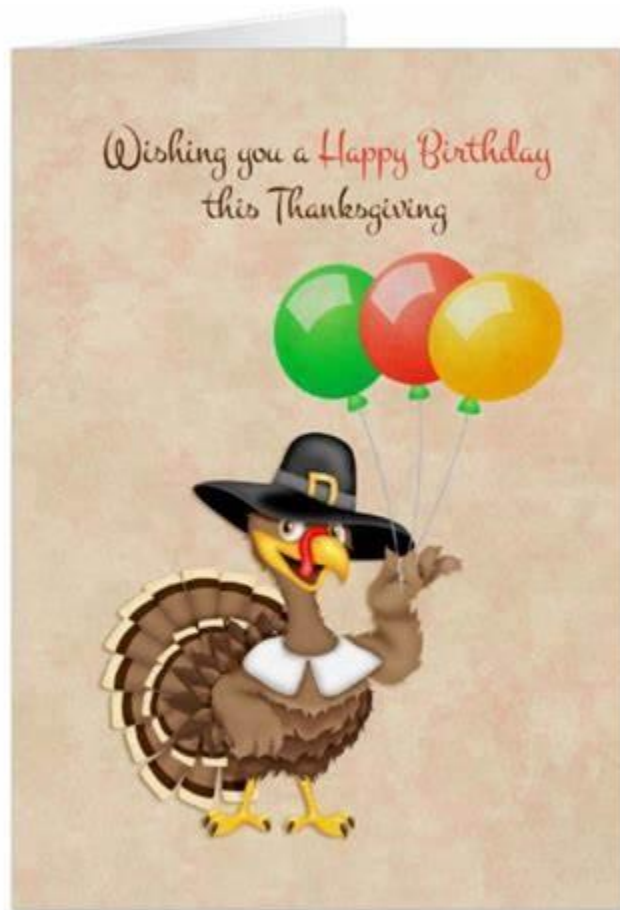
