
POINTS TO PONDER

So you think you can drive fast?

In April, Garett and I had the opportunity to attend both days of the MCA High Performance Driving Event at Michelin Raceway Road Atlanta held in conjunction with the MCA show. It was a total blast! It is hard to put into words the feeling of hitting 145 on the back straight, cresting the hill feeling the back end dance around as you brake for a 90 degree left at the bottom, or the feeling of weightlessness when passing under the entry bridge where the road totally disappears but you know you have to steer to the right or you will be in the grass.



If you ever have the opportunity, I highly recommend the HPDE events. Not only will you be able to test the limits and abilities of your vehicle, but also your own limits and abilities. Your skill level and car don't matter, as long as you are both safe and track worthy. All beginner drivers get a ride-along driving coach that is highly familiar with the track. They will help get the most out of your car, and out of you, showing what lines are the fastest, when to brake and turn, and what to **NOT** do.

Drivers are classed by level of experience – Beginner, Novice, Intermediate, Advanced and Very Advanced. If you have never been on a track you are automatically in the Beginner group. Each group goes out for 20 minute sessions so you are driving with others of your



level. Convertibles are restricted to the Beginner group and limited to 80 MPH (more or less...) I started in the Beginner class with a great instructor and was moved up to Novice on day two because I kept passing people. Many thanks to the Ponders for letting me throw my track tires in their truck and having power tools to make the swap easier!

Garett wasn't 18 so he couldn't drive on the track, but he did get to ride with a cou-

ple of Very Advanced drivers, once in a prepped Bullitt and once in a fully race prepped GT350R. Both drivers went full out and he came back with a really big smile.

Al in all it was worth the drive to Atlanta and the hassle of swapping tires. And I got to spend a long weekend with Garett before college.
